

Girari's Glass Table Top Decorating Shootout Guidelines

1. Team entries are invited until November 5 at 5 p.m. In the event there are more entrants than the eleven tables designated, entries will be randomly drawn, and those entrants not drawn will have first priority for the following table top shootout.
2. Each team will decorate a glass or acrylic top table. The tables will be triangular, square, rectangular and pentagonal, both in dining and bar heights, with appropriate seating.
3. Each team will be randomly assigned a specific table two weeks before the competition. Teams will provide all tabletop décor and agree to remove their décor from the venue the night of the competition.
4. There is no height limit (up to ballroom height) to a decoration except that no tents may be erected over and around the table. The 'footprint' of the table including décor off of the table is limited to two feet away from the edge of the table.
5. Teams will have between noon and 5 pm on the day of the event to decorate and remove extra materials from the table area. At precisely 5 pm, teams must leave the competition area.
6. No team names may be left on the tables until after the judging period. At 6 pm, teams may return to their tables and place informative material about themselves and their table decor.
7. The judging of the event will be from 5 pm to 6 pm.
8. At 6 pm, the event begins.
9. At 8 pm, the winners will be announced.
10. Prizes
 - a. First Prize: \$5,000 in event furniture rental credits.
 - b. Second Prize: \$3,000 in event furniture rental credits.
 - c. Third Prize: \$1,000 in event furniture rental credits.
 - d. Fourth Prize: \$1,000 in event furniture rental credits.
 - e. Fifth Prize: \$1,000 in event furniture rental credits.
11. There will also be a People's Prize award judged by the event guests who will submit votes for their favorite teams on their business cards. The award will be a recycled aluminum design from Girari.
12. In addition, there may be additional awards from the sponsors.
13. Judges will use a voting scale of 1 to 10 in each of the following three categories:
 - a. Creativity - The "Wow" factor
 - b. The Decorator's Interpretation of the Table's Design
 - c. Workmanship
14. Sustainability is not a requirement. Nor is the practicality of the table décor.
15. Teams will allow Girari to use photographic images of all tabletop décor in any media format, including the Girari web site.
16. Teams will leave tables dressed until the end of the event. Teams must break down and remove tabletop materials on the evening of the event.
17. The awards must be used for one event and redeemed within one year.

10. Clear Acrylic Box Dining Height (two 36x36x30H - -seating for 10)
11. Clear Acrylic Box Bar Height (two 36x36x42H - seating for 8)
12. Round Dining Height (seating for 8)
